### KPGA MARKETER DUES SCHEDULE

\* Please attach a list with contact names, addresses, and phone numbers for additional bulk plant locations or to add additional names to the mailing list. For purposes of dues, a “**Bulk Plant Location**” is defined as: “A facility where the primary function is to store LP-Gas prior to further distribution. LP-Gas is received by cargo tank vehicle, or pipeline, and then distributed by portable container (package) delivery, by cargo tank vehicle, or through gas piping.”

### NPGA MARKETER DUES SCHEDULE

All marketer members must pay dues for the National Propane Gas Association in addition to Kentucky Propane Gas Association dues based on the following dues structure:

1st – 2nd Bulk Plant <i>or</i> Headquarters	\$360.00
3rd – 5th Bulk Plant ( <i>additional combined price</i> )	\$195.00
6th – 500th Bulk Plant ( <i>per bulk plant</i> )	\$185.00
Greater than 500 Plants ( <i>per bulk plant</i> )	\$93.00

For example, a company with two bulk plants would pay \$360 in NPGA dues. A company with five bulk plants would pay \$555 (\$360 + \$195). A company with 30 bulk plants would pay \$5,040 (plants 1-5 would be \$555, plants 6-30 would be \$4,625).
